

I met Chris at our community supper last week. Chris is a resident of Greenville Falls (AKA Philbrick Elderly Housing). He washes dishes at a local restaurant and cleans a local church. He has a disability that gives him an obvious tremor and affects his speech and gait. Yet he was signing up people to sponsor him for the Walk for the Poor. On first meeting him, this earnest and modest man gave me a present. Two $4\frac{1}{2}$ inch by $5\frac{1}{2}$ inch pieces of paper, covered on both sides with handwritten bible verses. He photocopies these at the library and passes them out to people he meets. It's a wonderful selection of verses. There was something about the fact that they were handwritten, and his obvious intent that the gift was for my benefit, that made the verses that much more impactful. We looked over the verses together and found that some of his favorites were also some of mine. He was very happy when I told him that I would use some of his selected verses in messages for our weekly newsletter.

Chris's example shows that we don't need special resources or abilities to give spiritual encouragement to those we meet, just a desire to share God's

word to make a difference in people's lives. It was a very good gift.
