Reasons and Excuses

Jesus called many to follow him. Some did so immediately others rejected or refused the offer. But there was the group who said "yes! But first let me......" Demonstrating their heart may have been in the right place but they lacked the willingness to put it into action.

What Luke is describing here isn't a parable told by Jesus or an example of his teaching. Luke is recording actual conversations between Jesus and would be disciples as he traveled throughout Israel. Many were excited about the arrival of this Messiah! They were impressed with his teaching and healing and were both anxious and excited to be a part of it.

From someone who was willing to follow Jesus "wherever You go" there was the expectation that there was a destination in mind. Another was willing but wanted to wait until his father had passed away. Perhaps an indication that he wasn't willing to give up the inheritance he expected to receive upon his father's death. Then there is the one who wanted a "going away" party.

"I will follow You, But....." is a promise all of us have made and will likely make again. "I will follow Jesus by feeding the poor....but first let me check my pantry to see if there is any food I don't need or want." Or "I will follow Jesus...but first I have to finish my career and retire with a good amount of money in my retirement account." Are there other reasons and excuses that keep us from following Jesus? What is your "but first....?"
